- The Application & Placement Fee is non-refundable; no test or placement can be arranged unless a fully completed and signed application form and the previous school report are forwarded to the school with this fee.
- The Entrance Fee is non-refundable and paid only once. It is paid within 2 weeks of acceptance of offer, or immediately in case of immediate entry.
- The Endowment Fee is paid within one month before the start of a term, or immediately in case of immediate entry. The Endowment Fee will be refunded on the permanent withdrawal of the student from the school, after deduction of any outstanding amounts owed to the school, providing that notice of intention to withdraw is given to the Head Teacher at least one month in advance. The Endowment Fee will be refunded six weeks after the last day of attendance or one month after submission date of this withdrawal form, whichever is latest.

Tuition Fee

These are payable in 3 terms installments; paid within 1 month before the start of a term, or immediately in case of immediate entry.

- Please note that if you wish to change the programme from Half day to Full day programme in the middle of the term, an additional fee of 900THB will be charged per day and an additional of 1,700THB will be charged per day for when you would like to add additional days in the week into the programme.
- Nursery Settling-In Period: In the first term of enrolment to our school, a half-day option is offered to support a smooth transition. From the second term onwards, students of Nursery can only select the programme as full day students only.

Examinations Fee for Students Year 11-13

Please kindly note that IGCSE/ As Level and A Level Examination Fees are not included in the standard tuition fees for students Year 11-13. Students in Year 11-13, the examination fees by the exam boards will be charged in Term 2 according to the number of the exams that they have registered for the course.

Please note that any students who register for the examinations pass the deadline given, a late fee will be applied for the subject.

Due date

Notification of fees due will be sent to parents one month before the start of term.

Late Payment Charges

If payment is not received on or before the due date, late payment charges will be charged at 1% per month. Overdue non-tuition fees would deny students' enrollment in school activities.

Refund of Fees

A refund of endowment fee will only be granted upon receipt of a signed, written notice of withdrawal, submitted to the Registrar by the legal guardians advising of their intention to permanently withdraw the child. For a refund of the Endowment Fee to be granted notification to withdraw must be provided on or before the following dates:

- 19 November 2026 for students not returning in Term 2/2026-2027
- 19 March 2027 for students not returning in Term 3/2026-2027
- 03 June 2027 for students not returning in Term 1 of Academic year 2027-2028

Refunds will be issued six weeks after the last day of the child's attendance, as long as the required notice, as outlined above, has been received. Sums refunded will reflect any unpaid fees, damages, and/or unreturned school property, with appropriate deductions applied.

Annual Review

All School Fees are reviewed annually. The fees may be subject to change.

Extra-Curricular Activities

Extra-Curricular Activities can be optional, or at times recommended. Parents will be notified and invoiced of any charges.

Meals

This fee is compulsory and includes mid-morning snacks, a Thai and International lunch, and afternoon snack.

Other Fees

The tuition fee may include, but are not limited to, transportation service, extra- and co-curricular trips and travel books, supplies, and other education materials, after school study supervision fees, late fees, etc.

Insurance

The school has accident insurance for students which covers up to Bath 20,000 per accident which is caused by an accident during school hours or on school trips outside. There is no charge to parents for this service.

Late Entry

For students entering the school late in the year, annual fees will be prorated on the basis of the percentage of weeks remaining in the year (including the week of entry) compared to the total annual weeks of tuition.



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Payment Dates – Billing Calendar

All fees are payable in advance of each of the three terms and are billed in accordance with the school's billing calendar as outlined below. Penalties apply where fees remain outstanding after the due date. All school fees and charges are reviewed annually.

If fees are not paid in full by the due date, the school may issue a written notice to parents specifying a revised payment deadline. Failure to meet this deadline may result in the student being unable to attend school for the term, unless authorised by the Director. Additionally, the school will not issue any reports or certificates until all outstanding invoices have been settled.

Methods of Payment

Payment should be made in Thai Baht using one of the following methods:

- 1) The payment method facilitated via QR code through School Sync, accessible at www.schoolsync.ai, is available for utilisation. Should individuals wish to access their invoices within the system, they are encouraged to contact our reception office for assistance with logging in.
- 2) By Credit Card – Paid at the School Cashier. The following bank charges apply:
 - 2.7% for debit cards, non-platinum credit cards, non-premium credit cards, and premium cards (including VISA, MasterCard, Premium Card, Smart TPN, WeChat, and Alipay)
 - 3.5% for UnionPay credit cards, JCB, and platinum cards
- 3) By Bankers draft or Cashier's cheque payable to "KAJONKIET INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL PHUKET".
- 4) By Crossed cheque (Account Payee Only) payable to "KAJONKIET INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL PHUKET" The cheque should be crossed // at the word "bearer". Please send your cheque to the school cashier before the due date for bank clearing. The child's name and class should be written clearly on the back. A charge of 400 Baht will be made for any dishonored cheque.
- 5) By Bank Transfer through Bill payment at any branch of Bangkok Bank. (A pre-printed form for this purpose is available at the School Cashier).
